PRESS RELEASE

April 28, 2021

On Wednesday, April 28, 2021 at approximately 2:44 AM, Precinct 8 Deputy B. Claunch was dispatched to the 16000 block of Mesa Verde Dr in reference to a disturbance between a male and a female. Before his arrival, dispatchers advised the female victim had fled the residence on foot. Upon reaching the scene, Deputy Claunch located the victim near the residence, and she was bleeding profusely due to a gunshot wound. Deputy Claunch immediately rendered aid by applying a tourniquet to the victim's arm.

Sergeant A. Cruz arrived shortly after and located the defendant in the front yard of the residence. Two handguns were observed laying on the ground nearby. Sergeant Cruz was able to apprehend the man without incident and identified him as 73 year old Patrick Loren Evans. Upon further investigation, it was learned Mr. Evans fired at the victim with a Smith and Wesson .357 magnum revolver, striking her in the right forearm. The victim exited the residence and was able to get away.

The Harris County District Attorney's Office was contacted and accepted Aggravated Assault with a Deadly Weapon, a 1st degree Felony. Mr. Evans was transported to the Harris County Joint Processing Center for booking on this charge. A bond has not yet been set in this case.
