**PRESS RELEASE**

February 23, 2021

On Sunday, February 21, 2021 at approximately 2:00 AM, Precinct 8 Deputy P. Garcia and Sergeant M. Ford were dispatched to the 3400 block of SH 146 in Seabrook in reference to a major crash involving a Seabrook Police patrol vehicle.

Upon arrival, it was learned that the Seabrook Police Department was blocking traffic around the scene of a structure fire when one of their patrol cars was struck by a vehicle. Officers on the scene stated the vehicle bypassed officers directing traffic and then collided with a marked patrol vehicle with its emergency lights activated. Deputies identified the driver of the vehicle as 46 year old Stacy Michele Gifford. Investigation into the crash yielded evidence that Gifford was intoxicated and she was charged with Driving While Intoxicated by Precinct 8. She was taken into custody upon her release from the hospital and was transported to the Harris County Joint Processing Center for booking. Her bond has been set at \$100 total.

Shortly after, Sergeant Ford returned to the scene where a second vehicle struck another Seabrook patrol car in the 2800 block of SH 146. The driver, 25 year old Zackariah Fletcher Moore, bypassed traffic cones traveling at a high rate of speed and struck the back of the marked patrol vehicle which had its emergency lights activated. Moore was found to be intoxicated and was placed in custody for Driving While Intoxicated by the Seabrook Police Department. He was charged with Unlawful Carry of a Weapon as well. His bonds were set at \$500 each. Sergeant Ford conducted the crash investigation for this accident.

Fortunately, there were no injuries to officers or the suspects.
