PRESS RELEASE

November 2, 2020

On Saturday, October 31, 2020 at approximately 11:41 PM, Precinct 8 Deputy M. Self observed a silver Dodge Charger traveling in the 7900 block of the E. Sam Houston Pkwy S. service road at 82 mph in a posted 50 mph zone. Deputy Self activated his emergency lighting in an attempt to initiate a traffic stop on the vehicle. The driver continued traveling eastbound in an effort to elude Deputy Self. Upon approaching the intersection of Pearland Pkwy., the vehicle disregarded the red traffic light and continued traveling at a high rate of speed while swerving in and out of traffic. The driver continued driving recklessly, disregarding the red traffic light at Beamer Rd. and nearly collided with another vehicle as he continued to flee eastbound at a high rate of speed. The driver braked aggressively at the intersection of I-45 and attempted to make a U-turn and struck a curb in the process. The impact caused the front passenger wheel to break off of the suspension.

The pursuit continued briefly northbound in the southbound lanes of the I-45 service road before finally coming to a stop approximately 100 yards from the intersection. The suspect exited the vehicle and began to evade on foot westbound towards the S. Sam Houston Pkwy E. Two female passengers remained in the vehicle and were immediately detained. Both passengers stated they had just met the suspect earlier in the day and gave a description of the suspect to Deputies.

A perimeter was set up in the immediate area to conduct a search for the suspect. The Department of Public Safety air support and a Houston Police Department K-9 unit were called to assist in locating the suspect. After an extensive search, air support led the deputies to a ditch at the 12100 block of Dickenson Rd. where a male was located matching the description of the suspect. The suspect was apprehended and identified as 18 year old Ta Shawn Jamarion Lymuel. While conducting a pat down of Lymuel, a Dodge Charger key fob was located on his person that was verified as belonging to the vehicle involved. Approximately 2.7 ounces of marijuana was seized during a search of the vehicle.

The Harris County District Attorney's Office was contacted and accepted felony charges of Evading Arrest/Detention in a Motor Vehicle. At the time of his arrest, Lymuel was also wanted on a felony arrest warrant for Evading Arrest Detention filed by the Harris County Sheriff's Office. Charges for Possession of Marijuana were declined by the DA's Office. Lymuel was transported to the Harris County Joint Processing Center where he is being held in a lieu of a \$5,000 bond.
