#### **PRESS RELEASE**

June 17, 2021

On Tuesday, June 15, 2021 at approximately 7:51 AM, Precinct 8 Deputy Escareno was assisting another deputy with a traffic stop in the 200 block of El Dorado Blvd when she observed a white Chevrolet Malibu parked at the Citgo gas station. A male reached inside the occupied vehicle as he appeared to be monitoring the deputies on the traffic stop. Due to this area being known for high narcotic activity, Deputy Escareno approached the parked vehicle to make contact.

The occupant of the vehicle was identified as 27 year old Kyra Ashlei Suarez. After speaking with Suarez, Deputy Escareno proceeded to conduct a consent based search of the vehicle and located a sunglasses case containing methamphetamine and several bags containing numerous amounts of driver's licenses, credit/debit cards, social security cards, checks, checkbooks, and mail. Deputies then made contact with a male inside the store who was identified to be the second occupant of the vehicle. The male was identified as 30 year old Coby Michael Kirchner. Upon further investigation, Deputies continued to conduct a more extensive search of the vehicle and located syringes and a container containing methamphetamine. Additional bags were located containing checks made out to Kirchner, checkbooks and folders containing mail, social security cards, and credit cards. Several spiral notebooks were also located containing lists of names with date of births, home addresses, social security numbers and bank account information.

The Harris County District Attorney's Office was contacted and accepted felony charges of Fraudulent Use/Possession of Identifying Information on both subjects. Additional charges for Possession of a Controlled Substance were accepted on Suarez. Kirchner's bond has been set at \$30,000 while Suarez's bonds have been set at \$25,000 for the fraud offense and \$2,500 for the narcotics offense. There is an on-going investigation in this case due to the amount of evidence recovered.
