#### **PRESS RELEASE**

April 8, 2021

On Monday, April 7, 2021 at approximately 06:53 AM, Precinct 8 Dayshift Deputies were dispatched to the area of Middlebrook Dr. and Bay Area Blvd. in reference to a wrong way driver. The vehicle was reported to have a flat front tire and was traveling on a rim. Deputies searched the area and were unable to locate the vehicle.

At approximately 1:36 PM, Deputies A. Peters and P. Morris were dispatched to the 3100 block of Acorn Wood Way in Clear Lake in reference to a welfare check. The reporting witness observed a vehicle parked in front of a residence occupied by a male who appeared to be sleeping. The vehicle matched the description of the previous wrong way driver call.

Upon contact with the male occupant, he was observed to have several pills in his hand which he attempted to hide in his pocket. The occupant was directed to step out of the vehicle for further investigation and was identified as 37 year old Jeffrey Allen Moses. Moses was found to have a pill bottle in his pocket containing 3.42 grams of Xanax and 1.68 grams of Methamphetamine. Deputies proceeded to conduct a probable cause based search of the vehicle and located 3 grams of marijuana and drug paraphernalia.

The Harris County District Attorney's Office was contacted and accepted a felony charge of Possession of a Controlled Substance (methamphetamine). Charges for Possession of Controlled Substance (xanax) were declined. Moses was also found have an outstanding warrant for Fail to Stop and Give Information filed by the Harris County Sheriff's Office. Moses was transported to the Harris County Joint Processing Center for booking. His bond has not yet been set.
