PRESS RELEASE

On Sunday, September 13, 2020 at approximately 8:24 PM, Deputies from Harris County Precinct 8 were dispatched to the Walgreens located in the 16500 block of El Camino Real in Clear Lake in reference to a theft in progress. The caller stated that the suspect was a known patron who has stolen from this location in the past. In this case, the suspect was said to have filled up a shopping cart with several cases of White Claw brand alcoholic beverages and left the store without paying. Deputy J. Gomez was in the area and located the male behind the store. He was identified as 38 year old Jason Terrell Dorsey, who is known to Precinct 8 Deputies from previous cases involving Theft, Indecent Exposure and Criminal Trespass to name a few. Deputy Gomez detained Dorsey and confiscated the basket full of stolen alcohol. He was taken back to the Walgreens where he was positively identified as the theft suspect. The property was then returned to store staff.

The Harris County District Attorney's Office was contacted and accepted a felony charge of Theft w/Previous Convictions. It was noted that Dorsey has been charged 15 previous times for Theft (Class B or higher) since 2006. He was ultimately booked into the Harris County Jail but has since been released on a General Order bond. In addition, this agency filed an unrelated case of theft following an incident that occurred on September 9, 2020 after investigation showed that Dorsey stole 4 cases of beer from the CVS store in the 900 block of Bay Area Blvd. In that case, the District Attorney's Office accepted the theft charge as a Class B Misdemeanor despite his having been convicted of theft more than two times previously. As a result, an arrest warrant will be issued for that offense.
