PRESS RELEASE

On Sunday, March 28, 2021 at approximately 3:47 PM, Precinct 8 Deputy A. Henderson observed a black Chevy sedan traveling in the 16900 block of the Gulf Freeway. A check of the registration indicated the vehicle was listed as stolen. Deputy Henderson along with other Precinct 8 Deputies initiated a felony traffic stop on the vehicle. Both occupants were detained without incident. The driver was identified as 42 year old Damian Desean Rolls. The driver and passenger both stated that they had just left the Studio 6 located at 15313 Gulf Fwy. Precinct 8 Deputies have made previous arrests for stolen vehicles and narcotics from this location.

During the course of the investigation, the vehicle was confirmed stolen through the Houston Police Department. Deputies made contact with the owner of the vehicle, and it was found that Rolls did not have consent to operate or be in possession of the vehicle. The vehicle was stolen from the Diamond Inn.

Deputies conducted an inventory of the vehicle (search incident to arrest) and located 1.1 grams of Methamphetamine, multiple plastic baggies, a scale and a glass pipe.

The Harris County District Attorney's Office was contacted and accepted charges of Unauthorized Use of a Motor Vehicle and Possession with Intent to Deliver. Rolls was transported to the Harris County Joint Processing Center for booking. His bond has been set at \$20,000.
