PRESS RELEASE

April 6, 2021

On Monday, April 5, 2021 at approximately 4:52 PM, Precinct 8 Deputies A. Peters and P. Morris were dispatched to the Skylar Pointe Apartments complex in the 1100 block of El Camino Village Dr in reference to a suspicious vehicle. Upon arrival, Deputies located a parked vehicle matching the description in the general location given. Deputies made contact with the occupant of the vehicle who was identified as 60 year old Madison, Michael Wayne.

While speaking with Madison, Deputies observed drug paraphernalia in plain view near the center console. Madison was asked to step out of the vehicle for further investigation. As Deputies attempted to detain Madison, he began to evade on foot running towards an apartment unit. Deputy Peters was able gain control of Madison before he entered the apartment. Madison began to actively resist and attempted to throw a large stack of cash wrapped in a rubber band. After a brief struggle, Madison was successfully detained without further incident. Deputies made contact with the person inside the apartment who identified herself as Madison's wife. The female retrieved the cash that landed outside the apartment and returned it to Deputies. Deputy Peters noticed there was significantly less cash than what she originally saw thrown by Madison. The female stated Madison holds on to her money, and she took what was hers.

Deputies proceeded to conduct a probable cause based search of the vehicle and located 30 small ziploc bags and 2 glass jars containing a total of 4.10 oz. of marijuana. The stack of cash was found to be separated into small increments, and the amount totaled \$568 in US currency.

The Harris County District Attorney's Office was contacted and accepted charges of Evading with a bond set at \$100 and felony Possession of Marijuana with a bond set at \$2,500. Madison was transported to the Harris County Joint Processing Center for booking.
