### **PRESS RELEASE**

March 8, 2021

On Friday, March 5, 2021 at approximately 11:42 PM, Harris County Precinct 8 Deputy K. Basurto observed a white Nissan sedan with expired registration traveling in the 5900 block of the E Sam Houston Pkwy S. The vehicle's registration showed to have expired in 2018.

Deputy Basurto initiated a traffic stop on the vehicle and made contact with the male driver who was identified as 35 year old George Dantel Slater. Slater was found to have an outstanding Parole Violation warrant for narcotics and was placed into custody after the warrant was confirmed.

Deputy Basurto proceeded to conduct an inventory of the vehicle (search incident to arrest) and located a Dewalt drill bag in the trunk containing the following:

- 18.5 grams Crack Cocaine
- 31 grams Methamphetamine
- 93 grams Marijuana
- 10 grams Xanax
- .38 caliber pistol
- 2 digital weight scales
- 2 packages of zipper seal bags
- \$1,732 in US currency

Deputy T. Brinkley and K-9 Evo arrived on scene where K-9 Evo positively alerted on the contraband. The Harris County District Attorney's Office was contacted and accepted charges of Possession with Intent to Deliver (cocaine), Possession with Intent to Deliver (methamphetamine) and Felon in Possession of Firearm. Slater was taken into custody and transported to the Harris County Joint Processing Center for booking. His bond has been set at \$100,000 total. The currency was seized.
